# What is this product?

TYPE: Mutual Fund. INTERNATIONAL EQUITIES. This fund complies with Directive 2009/65/EC.

**TERM:** This fund may not be suitable for investors who expect to withdraw their money in less 10 years.

**OBJECTIVES:** 0-100% of total exposure is invested in equities or public/private fixed income assets (including deposits and listed or unlisted, liquid money market instruments). Exposure to currency risk will be 0-100% of total exposure.

For the selection of equity securities, fundamental analysis techniques are applied, seeking undervalued securities with high appreciation potential, and for fixed income, the most appropriate assets will be selected according to their risk-return profile.

There is no predetermination by type of issuers (public/private), currencies, economic sectors, market capitalization, average duration of the fixed income portfolio or rating of issues/issuers (therefore the entire fixed income portfolio may be of low credit quality, or even unrated). Issuers/markets will be OECD or emerging markets, without limitation. There may be geographic and/or sector concentration.

Investing in low credit quality fixed income or small cap equities may have a negative impact on the fund's liquidity. Up to 10% of the assets may be invested in financial CIS (eligible assets), whether harmonized or not, from the Manager's group or not.

More than 35% of the assets may be invested in securities issued or guaranteed by an EU State, an Autonomous Community, a Local Entity, International Organizations of which Spain is a member and States with solvency no less than that of Spain. The CII diversifies investments in the assets mentioned above in at least six different issues. The investment in securities of the same issue does not exceed 30% of the assets of the CII.
